Dear parents and carers

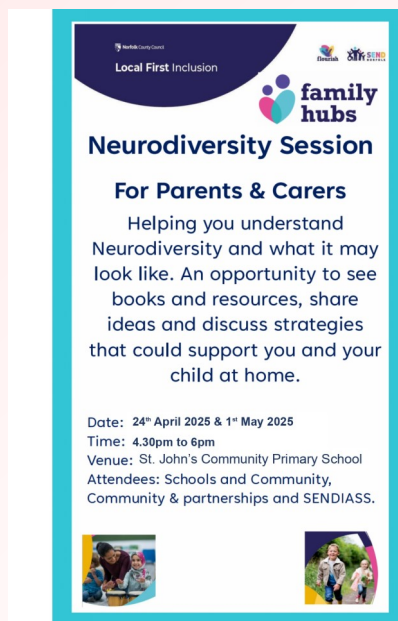
