**Attendance on the day**

Up to **two parents/carers per participating child** will be invited to attend the festival at BHS. You will be welcome to stay for the whole day or attend your child's specific performance slot. Further details about timings and individual performance slots will be shared closer to the event.

**Auditions and preparation**

All pupils across the school are warmly encouraged to practise the audition pieces (attached) over the Easter holidays. These will be judged by **Mrs Beckett** during the **first two weeks back after Easter**.

From these auditions, **20 pupils will be selected** to represent the school, either in **solo, paired** or/and **choral** entries, at the next stage of the festival. If your child is selected, they will then work with staff to further develop and refine their performance piece before being entered into the competition.

This is a fantastic opportunity for children to develop their confidence, creativity and communication skills, and we strongly encourage all pupils to take part in the audition process.

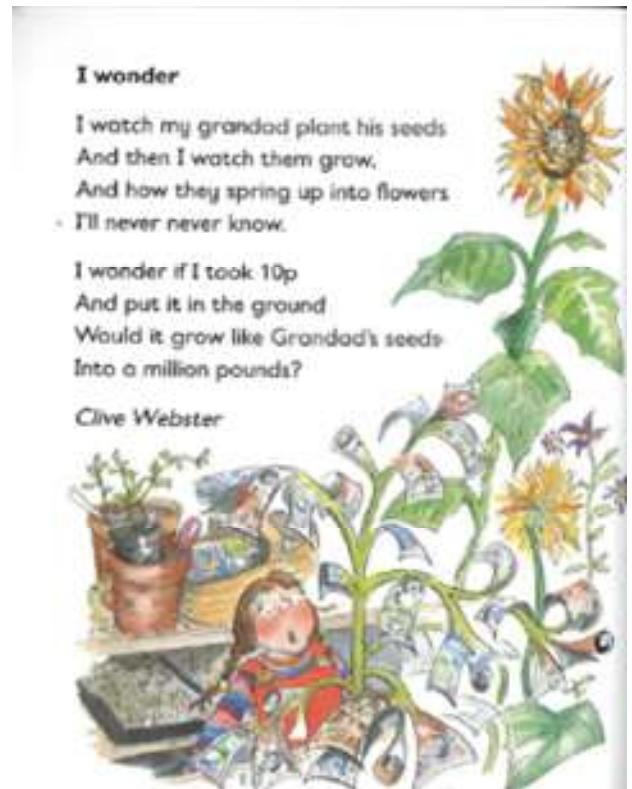
